



## Provisions for Display of Artwork

1. Art work must have approval from Great Basin Federal Credit Union before permission will be granted to display artwork.
2. All artwork will be displayed on existing wall anchors. This will limit the number and size of pieces to be displayed. No additional wall anchors, hooks, or any other hanging devices will be installed to accommodate art work.
3. The minimum size of the artwork must be 11" x 14" and/or the minimum size of the frame is 16" x 20" (i.e. a photo may be 11" x 14" but the frame must be 16" x 20" or a painting may be on a 16" x 20" canvas).
4. Art work will be tasteful and non-offensive in nature. Prohibited artwork includes but is not limited to:
  - a. Subject matter containing political or religious content or reference
  - b. Anything that can be construed as racist, sexist, or otherwise derogatory
  - c. Any person photographed, painted, or otherwise represented as not fully clothed or in offensive clothing
  - d. Anything sexual in nature, explicit or implicit
  - e. Subject matter that is considered violent, bloody, or gory
5. Art work shall be displayed in a professional manner. Artwork may be refused if it is not properly framed.
6. This shall not be a venue for family photos or children's art.
7. Artwork will not be allowed to be sold or listed for sale while displayed. However, the artist may have an "about the artist" article with contact information displayed providing that the article is framed.
8. Displays will run for one quarter. Artwork will be displayed starting on the first of the month (or the Monday following) of the quarter and will be removed from display on the last day of the month (or the Friday preceding) of the quarter. It is the artist's responsibility to pick up artwork within 1 week of being removed from display. Unclaimed artwork may be disposed of according to the manager's discretion.

- a. The duration of display may only be increased if there are no other artwork submissions for the following quarter. Approval from the artist must be obtained.
    - b. Artwork may not be removed before the end of the month without approval from Great Basin Federal Credit Union.
  9. Great Basin Federal Credit Union is not responsible for theft, damage, or loss of artwork from fire, flood, or other acts of God.
  10. Great Basin Federal Credit Union reserves the right to amend this policy at any time, refuse artwork for any reason, and discontinue a display at any time.
