



# Quicken for Mac 2015-2017 Conversion Instructions

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*Web Connect to Direct Connect*

## Introduction

As **Great Basin Federal Credit Union** completes its system conversion, you will need to modify your Quicken settings to ensure the smooth transition of your data. Please reference the dates next to each task as this information is time sensitive.

To complete these instructions, you will need your User ID and Password for each Financial Institution.

**NOTE:** **Express Web Connect** uses the same User ID and Password as the **Great Basin Federal Credit Union** website. **Direct Connect** for **Great Basin FCU** requires registration. Log into Online Banking. Click **Additional Services**, then **Connectivity for Quicken and QuickBooks**. Set the password you plan to use with your Intuit products. You will need to use your Online Banking User ID and this new password when connecting.

You should perform the following instructions exactly as described and in the order presented. If you do not, your online banking connectivity may stop functioning properly. This conversion should take 15–30 minutes.

## Documentation and Procedures

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### Task 1: Conversion Preparation

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1. Backup your data file. For instructions to back up your data file, choose **Help** menu > **Search**. Search for **Backing Up**, select **Backing up data files**, and follow the instructions.
2. Download the latest Quicken Update. For instructions to download an update, choose **Help** menu > **Search**. Search for **Updates**, select "Check for Updates," and follow the instructions.

### Task 2: Connect Accounts to **Great Basin FCU** on or after **04/18/18**

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1. Select your account in the **Accounts** list on the left sidebar.
2. Choose **Accounts** menu > **Settings**.
3. Select **Set up transaction download**.
4. Enter **Great Basin FCU** in the **Search** field, select the institution name in the **Results** list and click **Continue**.
5. Enter your Direct Connect **User Id** and **Password** and click **Continue**.
6. If the bank requires extra information, enter it to continue.

**NOTE:** Select "Direct Connect" for the "Connection Type" if prompted.

7. In the "**Accounts Found**" screen, associate each new account to accounts in your Quicken data file. Under the **Action** column, select "**Link**" to pick your existing account. When complete, click **Finish**.

**IMPORTANT:** Do **NOT** select "**ADD**" under the action column unless you intend to add a new account to Quicken.
